Casey Catherine Moore (she/her) is a bipolar, bisexual poet, writing coach, and educator. She holds a Ph.D. in Comparative Literature from the University of South Carolina, where her research focused on Latin poetry, invective, and gender studies. Her disability and mythology-inspired poetry collection, Psyche, was published by Anxiety Press in September 2024. Casey's current work as a poet, performer, teaching artist, and writing coach centers on gender, sexuality, and dis/ability and can be found in various academic and creative publications, including The Comparatist, Anodyne, Samfiftyfour, and Oyster River Pages. Casey founded the gueer and neurodivergent open mic series Electric Euphoria, co-produces and co-hosts the queer poetry/comedy series Homo Stanzas, and hosts open mics at Busboys and Poets at the Brookland location in Washington, D.C. She teaches creative writing and Greco-Roman Studies courses at Georgetown University and works with many community organizations through poetry workshops, including Arts for the Aging and the DC Commission on the Arts and Humanities. Casey draws inspiration from the madness and beauty within herself, those she works with, and all the glorious complexity in nature and all around us.
